

Tag Import Documentation

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Documentation : Tag import

1. Introduction

Tags are localised, named annotations that you can add comments to. These tags can be imported into MySurvey.

2. The tag file

The file containing the tags is a text file with the extension ".txt". Each line of the file corresponds to a tag. Within a line, the different descriptive fields of the tag must be separated by semicolon.

```
TAG_NAME ; X ; Y ; Z ; PICTURE ; COMMENT
```

- TAG_NAME: this parameter corresponds to the name of the annotation that will be displayed in MySurvey.
- X: the X coordinate of the annotation from the origin of the project coordinates.
- Y: the same applies to the Y coordinate
- Z: the same applies to the Z coordinate
- IMAGE: this is the desired image for the annotation. To do this, use the path from the ANNOTATIONS folder and use "\" to represent the tree view. For example: `Divers\photo.png`. If no particular image is desired, you must put a single space and the default image `"annotation.png"` will be used.
- COMMENT: the text will be placed in the comment field for the annotation in question.

3. Importing the tag file

To import your tag file(s), go to the [System/Import coordinates list](#) menu. You can select several files to import at the same time. These files will be imported under the "OBJECTS" group and the points will be imported under the group with the file name. You can after rename the annotations or modify the comments.
